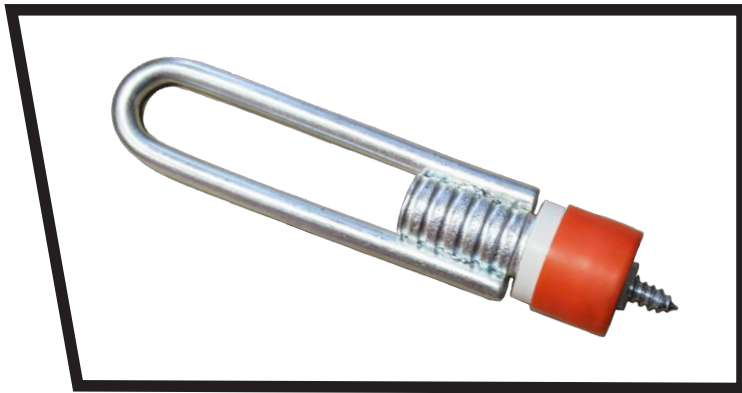

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## STRAIGHT LOOP INSERT

### 1. How does the Straight Loop Insert work?

(A) The Straight Loop Insert is a pre-installed receptical that is cast-in place during construction of the surface for the purpose of attaching an ANSI/OSHA certified anchorage connector once the concrete has cured to at least 3000psi.

### 2. Does the Straight Loop Insert comply with any safety standards?

(A) The Straight Loop Insert complies with both OSHA 1910.66 and OSHA 1926.502. It is also compatible with ANSI rated anchorage connectors.

### 3. What is the strength rating of the Straight Loop Insert?

(A) The breaking strength of the Straight Loop Insert is 10,000 lbs.

### 4. Can I buy the Straight Loop Insert without any other hardware?

(A) The Straight Loop Insert is only available with the Hardware Kit.

### 5. Is there a difference in the steel or wood installation?

(A) If installing in steel, the decking must be removed to access the anchor point.

### 6. What is the diameter of the plastic bolt included in the Hardware Kit?

(A) The plastic bolt included is 5/8 - 11 x 1". To install any anchorage connector, a grade 8, 5/8"-11 bolt is required with a length dependent on the installed anchorage connector.

### 7. Which anchorage connectors work best with the Straight Loop Insert?

(A) The Straight Loop Insert is intended to work with the Mega Swivel. However, it is compatible with any anchorage connector that is designed for use with 5/8"-11 bolt.

### 8. How does the Straight Loop Insert compare to a concrete strap?

(A) The Straight Loop Insert has twice the strength rating of a concrete strap. It is also more reliable and is more easily identifiable due to the orange housing.
