Dropped Objects Prevention

Tool lanyards can provide a primary way of securing tools and preventing them from dropping and injuring someone. However, there are additional precautions to take on the job to reduce the chance of a dropped object and risk of injury.

For Example:

- Eliminate the hazard altogether by preventing employees from being in areas where materials can fall from above.
- Install toe boards to guard rail systems to reduce the chance an object is accidentally kicked or knocked to a lower level.

- Add netting or canopy systems to prevent dropped objects from reaching a lower level work area.
- Regulate/restrict the number of tools used at height.
- Use of proper head protection.
