

EM385 Fall Protection Competent Person Course

This EM385 Fall Protection Competent Person course is designed for anyone who will be working on a US Army Corps of Engineers site or another site that it might be required. The course will provide students with the knowledge to identify existing and potential fall hazards and the means to mitigate them.

Topics covered:

- Fall hazard elimination and control measures
- Applicable fall protection regulations
- Fall hazard surveys and fall protection plans and procedures
- Responsibilities of designated persons under the standards
- Detailed inspection and care of equipment components and systems
- Fall protection system assessments to determine when a system is unsafe
- Fundamentals of fall protection rescue
- EM385 fall protection requirements

This course includes classroom and hands-on activities with both a written and practical exam. Upon successful completion, each student will receive a certificate and wallet card acknowledging completion of EM385 Fall Protection Competent Person training that meets and exceeds OSHA, ANSI and EM385-1.1 March 2024 Fall Protection requirements.
